



## Request for Nominations:

### 2014 *Let's Move!* Cities, Towns and Counties Awards

The National League of Cities (NLC) is excited to announce a call for nominations for three awards open to *Let's Move!* Cities, Towns and Counties (LMCTC) participants. **The deadline for all applications is October 24, 2014.**

#### Most Innovative City/Town/County Award

To apply, submit the following information about your LMCTC accomplishments in narrative form (2 page limit):

- Name of city or county
- Name of elected official representing city/county and contact information
- Name of point of contact for city/county and contact information
- Describe innovative accomplishments, including policies, programs, or strategies (10 pts.)
- Describe impact of efforts (5 pts.)
- Describe sustainability and legacy of efforts (5 pts.)
- Describe city's/county's role and the role of local partners (5 pts.)
- Timeframe of work. Note: these accomplishments must have occurred during the city's/county's participation in LMCTC. (5 pts.)

*Nominations will be scored out of 30 points.*

#### Most Dedicated Local Elected Official Award

To apply, submit the following information in narrative form (1 page limit). Nomination must come from a city/county staff person.

- Name and title of local elected official being nominated
- Name and contact information for nominator (must be a city/county staff person)
- Describe major achievements related to LMCTC (10 pts.)
- Describe actions/leadership taken beyond expectations, including the legacy of the work (10 pts.)
- Timeframe of work. Note: these accomplishments must have occurred during the city's/county's participation in LMCTC. (5 pts.)

*Nominations will be scored out of 25 points.*

#### Most Dedicated City/County Staff Person

To apply, submit the following information in narrative form (1 page limit). Nomination must come from a local elected official.

- Name and title of city/county staff person being nominated
- Name and contact information for nominator (must be a local elected official)

- Describe major achievements related to LMCTC (10 pts.)
- Describe actions/leadership taken beyond expectations, including the legacy of the work (10 pts.)
- Timeframe of work. Note: these accomplishments must have occurred during the city's/county's participation in LMCTC. (5 pts.)

*Nominations will be scored out of 25 points.*

Award recipients will be honored at a ceremony at NLC's [Congress of Cities and Exposition](#) in Austin, Texas on Thursday, November 20, 2014 from 3:30 to 5:00 pm CT.
