



Request for Nominations:

2014 Let's Move! Cities, Towns and Counties Awards

The National League of Cities (NLC) is excited to announce a call for nominations for three awards open to *Let's Move!* Cities, Towns and Counties (LMCTC) participants. **The deadline for all applications is October 24, 2014**.

Most Innovative City/Town/County Award

To apply, submit the following information about your LMCTC accomplishments in narrative form (2 page limit):

- Name of city or county
- Name of elected official representing city/county and contact information
- Name of point of contact for city/county and contact information
- Describe innovative accomplishments, including policies, programs, or strategies (10 pts.)
- Describe impact of efforts (5 pts.)
- Describe sustainability and legacy of efforts (5 pts.)
- Describe city's/county's role and the role of local partners (5 pts.)
- Timeframe of work. Note: these accomplishments must have occurred during the city's/county's participation in LMCTC. (5 pts.)

Nominations will be scored out of 30 points.

Most Dedicated Local Elected Official Award

To apply, submit the following information in narrative form (1 page limit). Nomination must come from a city/county staff person.

- Name and title of local elected official being nominated
- Name and contact information for nominator (must be a city/county staff person)
- Describe major achievements related to LMCTC (10 pts.)
- Describe actions/leadership taken beyond expectations, including the legacy of the work (10 pts.)
- Timeframe of work. Note: these accomplishments must have occurred during the city's/county's participation in LMCTC. (5 pts.)

Nominations will be scored out of 25 points.

Most Dedicated City/County Staff Person

To apply, submit the following information in narrative form (1 page limit). Nomination must come from a local elected official.

- Name and title of city/county staff person being nominated
- Name and contact information for nominator (must be a local elected official)

- Describe major achievements related to LMCTC (10 pts.)
- Describe actions/leadership taken beyond expectations, including the legacy of the work (10 pts.)
- Timeframe of work. Note: these accomplishments must have occurred during the city's/county's participation in LMCTC. (5 pts.)

Nominations will be scored out of 25 points.

Awards Ceremony

Award recipients will be honored at a ceremony at NLC's <u>Congress of Cities and Exposition</u> in Austin, Texas on Thursday, November 20, 2014 from 3:30 to 5:00 pm CT.
