2015 *Let's Move!* Cities, Towns and Counties Awards

The National League of Cities (NLC) is excited to announce a call for nominations for two awards open to *Let's Move!* Cities, Towns and Counties (LMCTC) participants. **The deadline for all applications is Friday, October 16, 2015.**

Most Dedicated Local Elected Official Award

To apply, submit the following information in narrative form (1 page limit). The nomination must come from a city/county staff person.

- Name and title of local elected official being nominated
- Name and contact information for nominator (must be a city/county staff person)
- Describe major achievements related to LMCTC (10 pts.)
- Describe actions/leadership taken beyond expectations, including the legacy of this person's work (10 pts.)
- Timeframe of work. Note: these accomplishments must have occurred during the city's/county's participation in LMCTC. (5 pts.)

Nominations will be scored out of 25 points.

Most Dedicated City/County Staff Person Award

To apply, submit the following information in narrative form (1 page limit). The nomination must come from a local elected official OR a fellow city/county staff person.

- Name and title of city/county staff person being nominated
- Name and contact information for nominator (must be a local elected official OR a fellow city/county staff person)
- Describe major achievements related to LMCTC (10 pts.)
- Describe actions/leadership taken beyond expectations, including the legacy of this person's work (10 pts.)
- Timeframe of work. Note: these accomplishments must have occurred during the city's/county's participation in LMCTC. (5 pts.)

Nominations will be scored out of 25 points.

Award recipients will be honored at a ceremony at NLC's [Congress of Cities and Exposition](#) in Nashville, Tennessee on Thursday, November 5, 2015 from 4:00 pm to 5:00 pm CT.
